Individuals, families, voluntary associations, scientific and medical societies, and corporations who endorse the need for improved awareness of and public advocacy for Canadian health research.

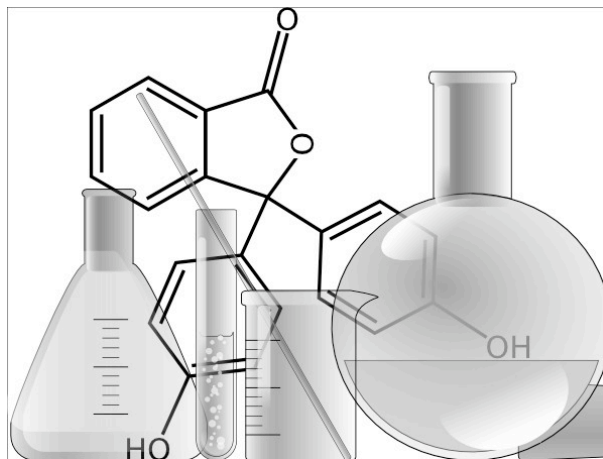

- **Future Health:** The official CHR magazine, launched in 1979. It is distributed free of charge to a thousand rural schools across the country.
- **sanofi pasteur Medal for Excellence in Research Journalism:** A \$2,500 bursary created in 1995 to highlight the pivotal role journalists play in raising public awareness of Canadian health research.
- **30<sup>th</sup> Year Celebration Monographs:** A series of articles reporting the progress in scientific research that is vital to the health of Canadians. Diseases highlighted include: multiple sclerosis, Parkinson's disease, cystic fibrosis, polio, mutagenesis, and tuberculosis.
